**Enzo Mancinone 1931 - 2007 SPRINGFIELD, MA -**

Enzo Mancinone, 76, of Scarsdale Road, entered into eternal rest on Wednesday, July 25, 2007 in Baystate Medical Center. Born in Castlemauro, Molise, province of Compbasso, Italy, he was the son of the late Nicola and Filomena (Manicchio) Mancinone and came to the United States in 1955.
